

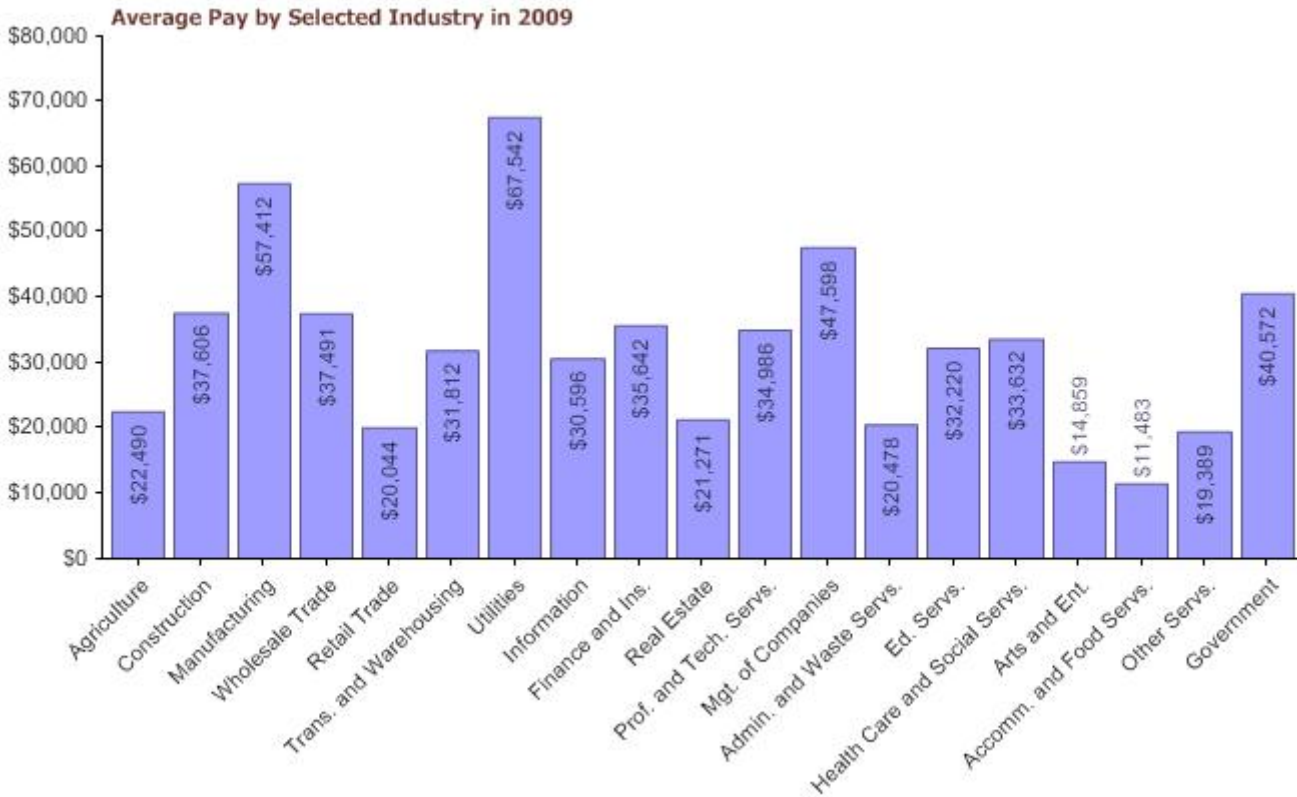
# Grant County, IN Highlights

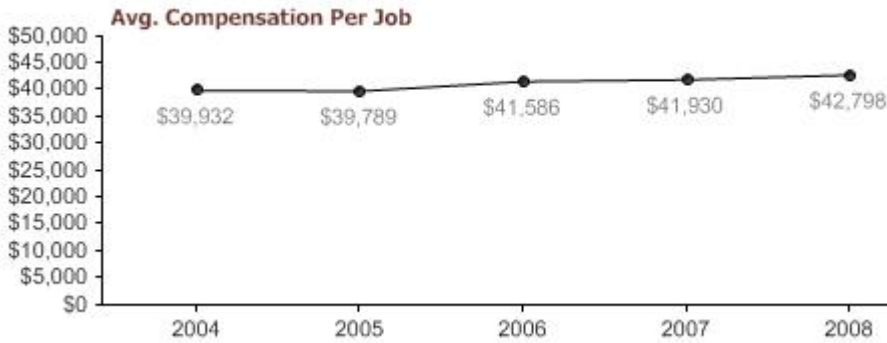

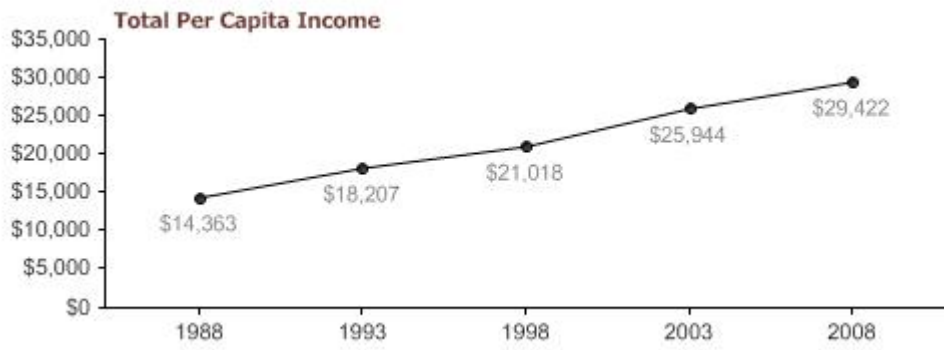
